I. Objective

In order to reward top and outstanding overseas Compatriot students studying in Taiwan for a bachelor's degree, based on the "Medium and Long-term Individual Social Development Project 2023 to 2026-Expanding the Cultivation and Retention of Overseas Compatriot Students" approved by the Executive Yuan's document Yuan Tai Wai Zi No.110024110 on August 31, 2022, the Overseas Community Affairs Council (OCAC) specifically stipulates the "OCAC Directions for Approval of Scholarships for Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students to Study at Universities in Taiwan."

II. Scholarship Amount

1. **Top Overseas Compatriot Students Scholarship:** NT\$260,000 per academic year, totaling NT\$1.04 million over four years.
2. **Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students Scholarship:** NT\$100,000 per academic year, totaling NT\$400,000 over four years.

III. Award Duration

1. The scholarship is awarded for a maximum of four years.
2. The award period runs from September 1 of the current academic year to August 31 of the following year.
3. If a student is suspended from school for any reason, his/her eligibility will be revoked and the scholarship will be stopped. The scholarships received during the year of suspension shall be paid back in full if the amount is less than one-half according to the period of study before suspension; if the scholarship is more than one-half but less than three-quarters, half shall be paid back; If more than three-quarters has been received, there is no need to return it.
4. Scholarship recipient should arrive at the school on time to register. Those who fail to come to Taiwan to study within the time limit will be deemed to have given up his/her eligibility to receive the scholarship and it will not be retained.
5. If a recipient transfers to another department, scholarship eligibility will be rescinded and the scholarship will be discontinued.

IV. Applicant Eligibility

1. Overseas compatriot students must have graduated from high school or above, have achieved excellent academic performance, good conduct, and meet the criteria of Article 2 of the " Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan" to study for a bachelor's degree.

2. Applicant must be admitted to designated AI-related departments, including Electrical Engineering, Electro-Optical Engineering, Computer Science & Information Engineering, and Mechatronic Engineering.
3. If applicant have already applied for the OCAC "Scholarship for Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students to Study at Universities in Taiwan" through Taiwan's overseas missions or designated units, he/she may only apply for this scholarship if he/she has not received the award or if it has not been confirmed whether he/she will receive the award.
4. Academic Requirements: (Before the application deadline, the applicant's grades in "Mathematics" and "Physics" during the entire duration of his/her high school or equivalent education must meet the following criteria)
 - (1) **Top Scholarship:** Average academic result of 88 or above in Mathematics and Physics, or top 5% in class. Conduct average result must be 80 or above.
 - (2) **Outstanding Scholarship:** Minimum scores of 85 in Mathematics and Physics, or top 10% in class. Conduct average result must be 80 or above.

* In consideration of variations in educational systems and grading methodologies across countries, the school shall convert grades in accordance with the " Grading Scale and Percentage Conversion Chart for Individual Subjects " and submit the results to OCAC for approval and record-keeping. In the absence of a conduct grade, the assessment shall be conducted based on alternative performance evaluation criteria.
5. Applicant with any of the following conditions is ineligible:
 - (1) Has retained his/her status at a domestic university or have registered to attend a domestic university in Taiwan.
 - (2) Has studied in Taiwan at the same level as the degree program you are applying for.
 - (3) While studying in the "Academy of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students" of National Taiwan Normal University".
 - (4) Students are exchange students or dual/joint degree students recruited by Taiwan's universities based on academic cooperation agreements signed with foreign schools.
 - (5) This scholarship has been revoked.
 - (6) While studying in Taiwan, also receive tuition and miscellaneous fee subsidies, exemptions, or scholarships and bursaries set by Taiwan government agencies (institutions); however, this does not include tuition and miscellaneous fee subsidies, exemptions, or scholarships and bursaries provided by the school where the student is a scholarship recipient.

V. Application Period

Applications are open from **July 1, 2025** to **August 15, 2025** (Taiwan time).

VI. Required Application Documents

- * Please upload the following documents in order to the registration website mentioned in Point 7. Only PDF files are accepted (maximum size: 10MB)
- 1. Completed scholarship application form (Attachment 1). After completing the form, sign it by hand, scan it, and upload it to the registration website.
- 2. A copy of the permanent or long-term residence permits the place of residence.
- 3. A copy of highest academic diploma and transcript (If it is in a language other than Chinese or English, a Chinese translation should be attached). The photocopy and translation should be verified by overseas missions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the ROC or Culture Centers of Taipei Economic and Cultural Offices or sponsoring unit designated by the OCAC.
- 4. Two recommendation letters from a principal, teacher, or tutor, sealed and signed.
- 5. Autobiography, including a study plan and motivation for applying to the university.
- 6. Documentation of outstanding achievements in related fields.
- 7. Internship plan during studies or plans for remaining in Taiwan after graduation.
- 8. Submission Checklist for the Overseas Community Affairs Council Scholarship to Reward Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students Studying in AI Related Departments at Universities in Taiwan (Attachment 2).

VII. Application Submission

Applications must be submitted online via the designated application website: <https://reurl.cc/96yv2O>. All required documents should be uploaded.

VIII. Principles for Selection and Scholarship Issuance

1. The Principles for selection and scholarship issuance are as follow :
 - (1) Selection involves a preliminary document review followed by online interview to determine primary and reserve awardees.
 - (2) The evaluation emphasizes plans for contributing to the AI industry.
 - (3) Preference is given to applicant with TOCFL Level 3 or above certification.
2. The final results will be approved by the OCAC and announced on both the OCAC and NTNU websites.
3. The procedures for the initial scholarship application, renewal eligibility, and review process are as follows: :
 - (1) Initial receipt: Students who have received the award at the beginning of the first academic year should submit the official letter from the OCAC approving the award and other documents proving the award to the school after registration in the first academic year.

(2) Eligibility for continuing receipt:

- A. Recipient who meets the above criteria must complete a minimum of 9 credits per semester during his/her studies. For recipient of the Top Scholarship, his/her cumulative academic GPA for the academic year must be A or 85 points or higher, and his/her **conduct grades must average at least 80 points** or above (or the equivalent). For recipient of the Outstanding Scholarship, his/her cumulative academic GPA for the academic year must be A- or 80 points or above, and his/her **conduct grades must average at least 80 points** or above (or the equivalent). If he/she participates in an exchange program during his/he studies, the credits and grades earned abroad must be recognized by the domestic institution he/she is enrolled in.
 - B. Those whose grades in the previous school year did not meet the current benchmark will not be allowed to apply. However, if grades in subsequent academic years reach the current benchmark, he/she may apply again.
 - C. Beginning from the second academic year, award recipient shall submit transcripts that comply with the requirements set forth in the preceding provision to NTNU when applying for scholarship renewal. NTNU shall review the award recipient's eligibility for renewal, submit the review evaluation to OCAC for approval, and duly notify the recipient. NTNU will process scholarship applications in accordance with the regulations."
4. If a scholarship recipient is found to have submitted falsified or inaccurate documents, or if he/she withdraws from school, the OCAC will revoke his/her eligibility. Any scholarship funds already received must be returned, and legal responsibility will be pursued based on the severity of the case.

Guidelines for the Prospectus of Scholarships for Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students for Studying AI-Related Department at National Taiwan Normal University in Taiwan

1. To align with the Overseas Community Affairs Council (OCAC) of the Republic of China's (Taiwan) initiative to encourage outstanding overseas compatriot students to pursue higher education in Taiwan in AI-related fields, National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU) establishes these "guidelines prospectus of scholarships for outstanding overseas compatriot students for studying AI-related department at National Taiwan Normal University in Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as "this Guidelines").
2. **Eligibility :**
 - (1) Applicant must be overseas compatriot students who has graduated from high school or above, with excellent academic performance and good conduct, and meets the requirements of Article 2 of the "Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas compatriot Students in Taiwan."
 - (2) Applicant must have been admitted to AI-related disciplines designated by NTNU and approved by OCAC for the current academic year.
 - (3) Applicant who has applied for the "Scholarship to Reward Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students" for Studying at NTNU in Taiwan through embassies, consulates, or designated agencies and has not been awarded or are still awaiting confirmation of the result is eligible to apply for this scholarship.
 - (4) Applicant must have grades in "Mathematics" and "Physics" from he/she entire high school period, equivalent to Taiwan's standards. For the Top Scholarship, both subject averages must exceed 88 points or be within the top 5% of the class. For the Outstanding Scholarship, the minimum average is 85 points or within the top 10% of the class. Conduct grades must average at least 80 points. In consideration of variations in educational systems and grading methodologies across countries, the school shall convert grades in accordance with the " Grading Scale and Percentage Conversion Chart for Individual Subjects " and submit the results to OCAC for approval and record-keeping. In the absence of a conduct grade, the assessment shall be conducted based on alternative performance evaluation criteria.
 - (5) Applicant is ineligible if he/she:
 - A. Has previously registered at or retained student status at a university in Taiwan.
 - B. Has studied the same degree program he/she is applying for.
 - C. Studied at NTNU's Academy of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students.
 - D. Was exchange or dual-degree students under agreements between NTNU and foreign universities.
 - E. Previously had this scholarship revoked.
 - F. Receive other tuition waivers or scholarships from the Taiwanese government (excluding those provided directly by NTNU).

3. Funding and Amount

The scholarship amount is based on the allocation approved by OCAC under the " Prospectus for the OCAC Scholarship To Reward Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students for Studying at NTNU in Taiwan."

- (1) Top Overseas Compatriot Students Scholarship: NT\$260,000 per academic year (same below), totaling NT\$1.04 million over four years.
- (2) Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students Scholarship: NT\$100,000 per academic year, totaling NT\$400,000 over four years.

4. Scholarship Quota

The number of scholarships available is determined annually by OCAC.

5. Duration of the Scholarship

- (1) The maximum duration of the scholarship is four years.
- (2) The scholarship is awarded annually, from September 1 of the current year to August 31 of the following year.
- (3) If a recipient takes a leave of absence, the scholarship will be terminated, and disbursed funds must be refunded proportionally.
- (4) Recipient who fails to begin his/her studies in Taiwan within the designated time will forfeit his/her scholarship.
- (5) Recipient who transfers to non-designated programs will has his/her scholarship terminated.

6. Application Submission

- (1) New students: Eligible students must submit the required application documents to the Office of International Affairs during the application period.
- (2) Renewals: Processed according to the annual announcement of the Office of International Affairs.

7. Review Procedure for New Student

- (1) A two-stage review process will be conducted, including a preliminary document review and interviews (in-person or virtual) to select primary and alternate candidates.
- (2) The review process shall be conducted by a review panel composed of no fewer than five faculty members of the university. The list of award nominees shall be submitted to OCAC for approval, and the final list of award recipient shall be determined by the OCAC. In the event of any disputes, the university's review panel reserves the final decision-making authority.

8. Supplementary Provisions

Matters not covered herein shall be handled in accordance with the relevant provisions of the " OCAC Directions for Approval of Scholarships for Top and Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students to Study at Universities in Taiwan ".

9. Implementation and Amendments

These guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the NTNU President. Amendments follow the same procedure.
