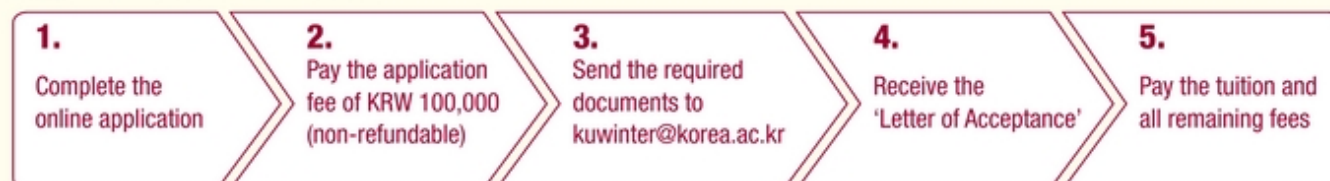
Eligibility

Required Documents

- ♦ Copy of passport
- ♦ Proof of health insurance (for students enrolled in in-person courses only)

Credit Transfer

Credits earned at KU IWC are widely transferable to most overseas institutions at the discretion of students' home institution. For credit transfer, students are advised to consult with the appropriate academic authorities at their home institution in advance by submitting the course syllabus available from the KU IWC website.

*** One course is worth 3 credits, equivalent to the U.S. credit system.**
