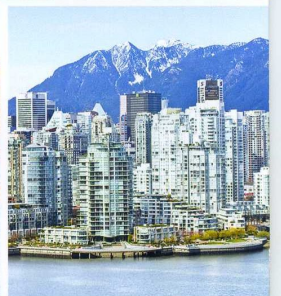
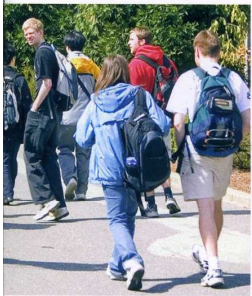

Hours of instruction per week: 26

- Full-time English language program covering every aspect of English.

- Completion of any level earns a UBC certificate.
- Level 600 Certificate accepted by UBC as proof of English language ability for undergraduate admission.

UBC CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

UBC's conditional admission program is for academically outstanding applicants who do not yet meet UBC's English language admission standard. You may apply to be admitted into a degree program on the condition that you develop your academic English to the required standard by following the academic stream of our Intensive English Program (IEP), described above.

Upon successful completion of the IEP, students proceed directly into their degree program.

Graduate Studies: Conditional admission to graduate programs is currently available. For details, view www.grad.ubc.ca/apply/how/caprogram.asp.

Undergraduate Studies: Currently, conditional admission is available only to academically outstanding students who are already attending an ELI program.

- Start dates throughout the year.

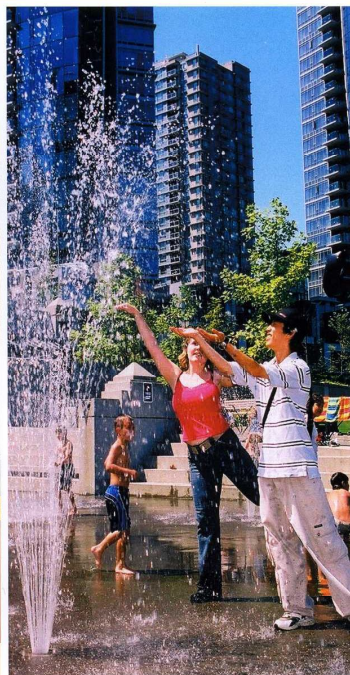

- Participate in simulated meetings and role plays.

- A non-refundable \$150 application fee is required at the time of all applications. Applications will not be processed without this payment.
- A non-refundable deposit is required for each program and the deposit is applied towards the tuition. The deposit for IEP is \$600, for all other programs it is \$300. If full tuition is paid at the time of registration, \$600/\$300 is considered the program deposit and is non-refundable.

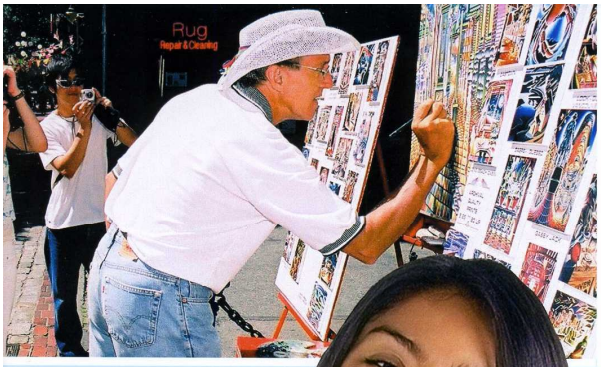

HOMESTAY

Placement Fee: \$200 CDN

Homestay Fee: \$30 CDN/night, meals included

- Improve your English while living with a Canadian family.
- Furnished private room and three meals a day.
- Host families include students in daily family life.
- Host families are selected carefully with students' comfort and safety in mind.
- Pre-homestay campus accommodation is available before the homestay placement day. Please note that due to the 2010 Olympics in Vancouver, pre-homestay is not available in Jan, Feb and Mar 2010.

CAMPUS STAY

Placement Fee: \$100 CDN

Campus Stay Fee: \$28.35 CDN/night

- Available from mid-May through mid-August.
- Single or shared room in a campus dormitory.
- Meet Canadian and international students.
- Experience campus life.

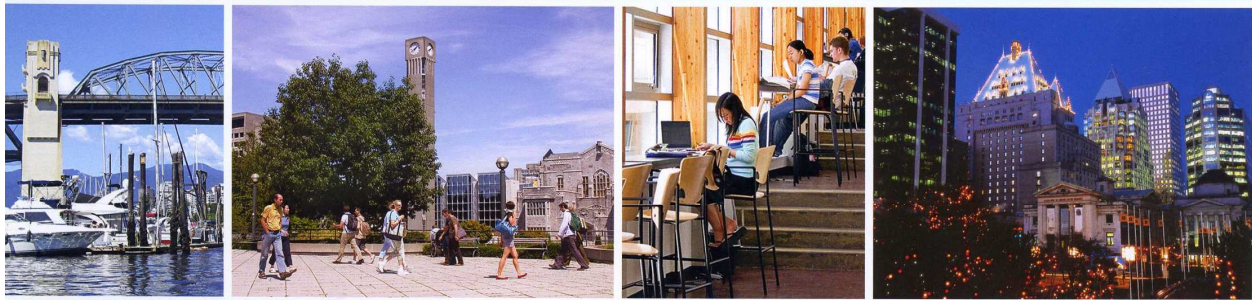
