## **Program overview**

The program combines two regular courses: Thai Society & Culture and Buddhism in Thailand. The program is an annual event held during the last week of June and the last week of July. The seminar will focus on the complex relationships between Buddhism and Thai history, politics, economics, education, literature, law, arts, and theatre. Participants will be instructed by distinguished scholars and professors at Thammasat University, Ta Prachan and will visit sites of particular historical importance, such as Ayutthaya and Chiengmai.

# PD223 Society and Culture of Thailand -- 3 credits

Thai society and culture as investigated in diverse anthropological methods, using case studies from various researches by Thai and international academics, emphasizing analytical and critical approaches.

#### PD353 Buddhism in Thailand -- 3 credits

An investigation of the role that Buddhist institutions in Thailand such as sects, organizations of Buddhists, practices as well as the functioning and roles of the various Thai religious institutions.

All course's credits will be granted for the successful completion of the program. Grading will be base on paper work and examination.

### **Program fee:**


