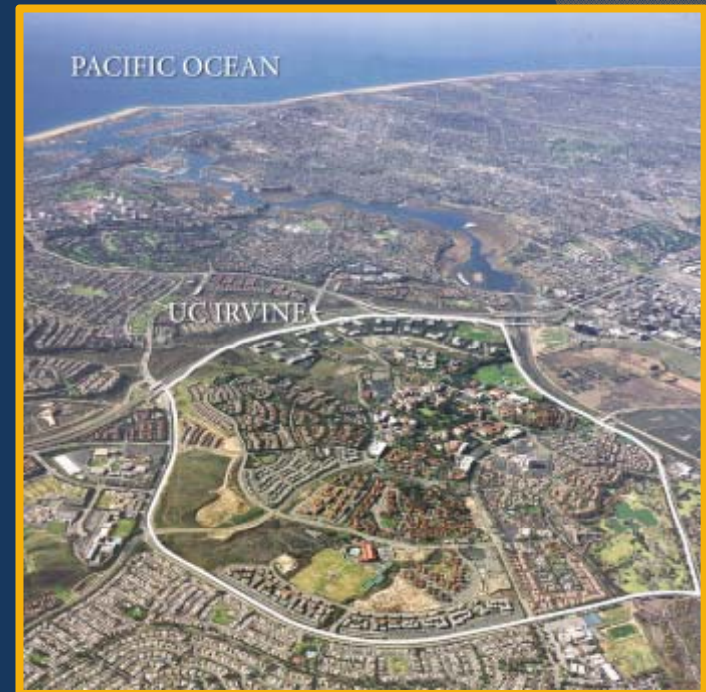

CAMPUS DORMITORY – SUMMER ONLY

- Group style housing/co-ed building/same-gender bedroom with domestics and international students

University Academics



International Students:

- Complete regular UCI courses attended by current UCI students
 - 800 course in 70 disciplines
- Are taught by UCI instructors
- May transfer college credit and grades to home university
- Will have learning support from professors, teaching assistants, and workshops

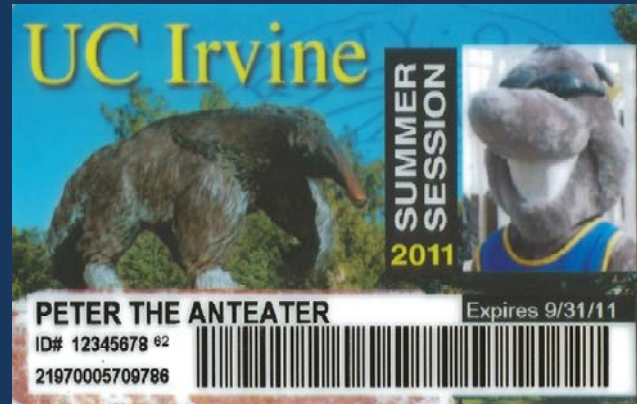
- Friday Social Hour: lemonade and cookies to catch up with friends and summer session staff

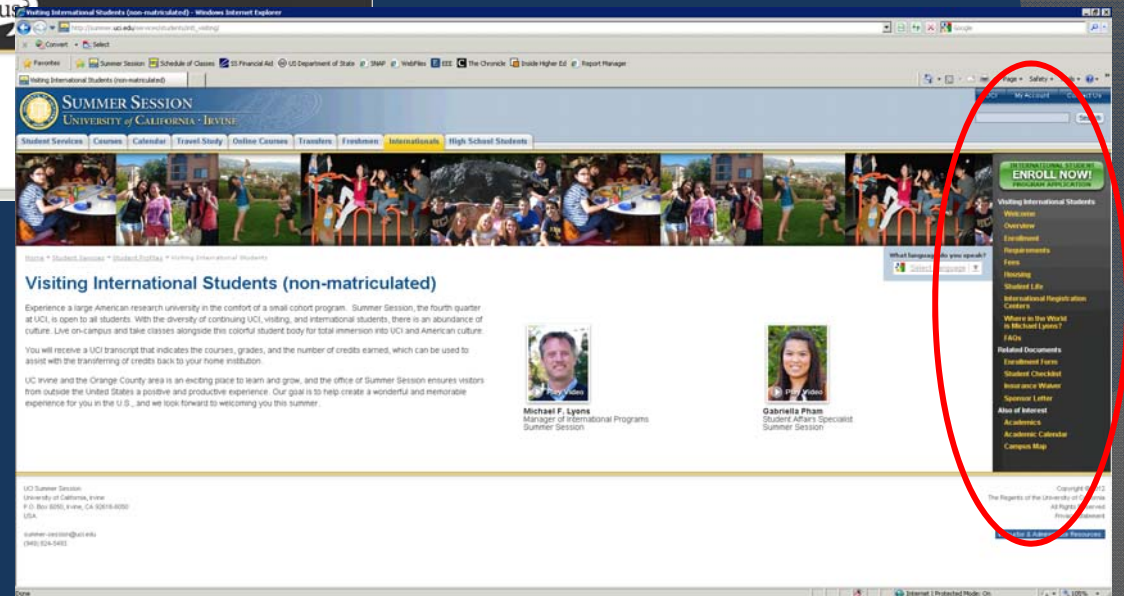
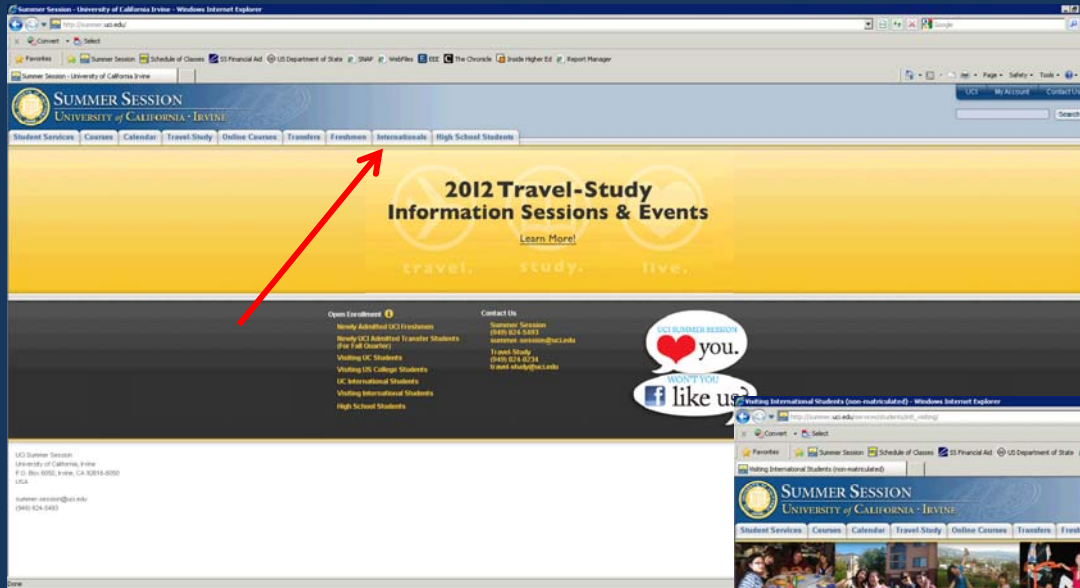

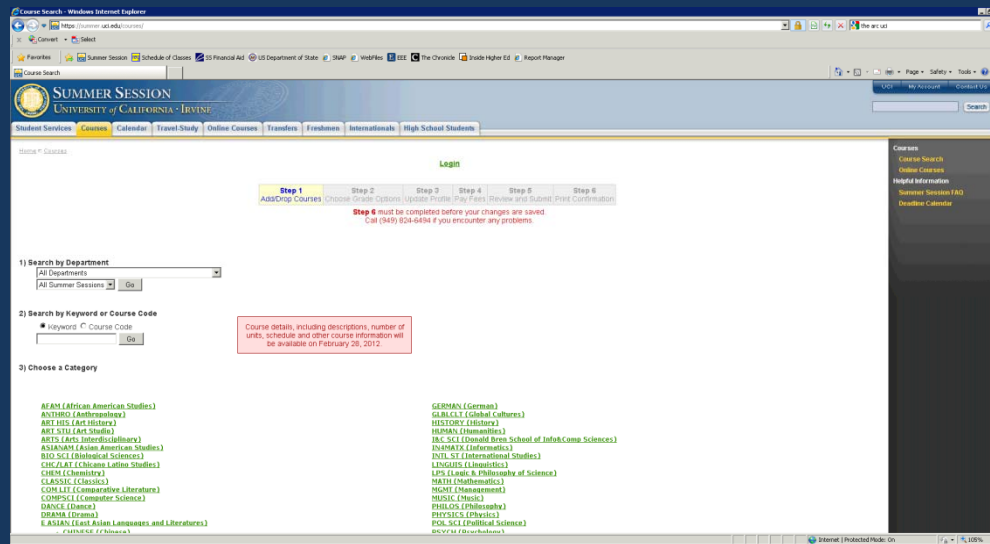
Requirements



- Proof of English Proficiency
 - TOEFL
 - Computer Based: 213, iBT: 79, Paper Based: 550
 - TOEIC: 760
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - Optional phone interview and transcript if necessary
- Documents to support issuance of I-20
- Health Insurance (or purchase from UCI)

How To Enroll

1. Choose your Session
2. Pick the courses you would like to study
3. Send us the completed Summer Session enrollment form and submit it along with your supporting documents.



Transcripts

You may transfer units earned and courses taken at UCI to your home university.

- First, speak to your academic advisor at your home university to confirm courses that you would like to take at UCI
- Second, obtain the address of the department and school official at your home university who should receive your official transcript at the end of the summer.
 - *A complete and correct address* is important to avoid delays in transferring credit.
- Upon arrival at UCI, Summer Session staff will assist you with necessary paperwork required to send official transcripts to your home university
- Upon returning home, follow up with your school officials to complete credit transfer.

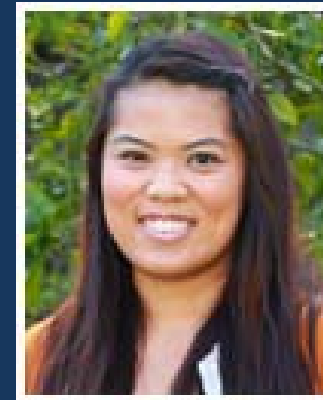
