Want to learn English while experiencing life on the campus of a Canadian university? Looking for a little adventure to go with your language learning? Then the University of Manitoba is your summer destination.

Whether you are a university or high school student, or are just looking for a dynamic learning environment to improve your English, the Intensive English Program Summer Language and Adventure Tour offers the chance to study English while enjoying the beautiful summer in the heart of Canada.

You can start your program at the beginning of June, July or August and study for one month or for all three months. It's up to you!

The Intensive English Program offers eight levels of English from beginner to advanced. For five hours a day, you participate in dynamic and engaging language classes that improve your communication skills. Classes include a variety of speaking, reading, listening and writing activities. You get a well-rounded learning experience and build confidence in using English in social, academic and professional settings.

In the classroom our university-trained teachers are not only experts in language training, but will also make you feel welcome and make learning enjoyable.

Outside of the classroom our Activity Leaders always plan fun and interesting events and encourage you to make friends and speak English. They can help you explore the city of Winnipeg!

### **Experience Manitoba Activities**

Our Experience Manitoba Activities are the adventure part of the Intensive English Program. On weekdays after classes and on weekends, activities are planned for students to enjoy the social and cultural scene in the city of Winnipeg and to practice English with friendly Manitobans.

#### Some of our Summer Experience Manitoba activities include:

- Professional sports games with the Winnipeg Goldeyes Baseball team and the Winnipeg Blue Bombers football team
- Day trips to the Icelandic town of Gimli and Grand Beach Provincial Park two of Manitoba's summer fun hotspots
- The Royal Winnipeg Ballet performing outdoors in Assiniboine Park
- Visits to the Exchange District and the Forks, both National Historic Sites of Canada
- · An evening boat cruise down the Red River
- Folklorama (a multi-cultural festival)

#### **IEP Adventures**

The Intensive English Program also offers special trips within the province of Manitoba and to other parts of Canada for our students.

In June and August join our IEP Adventure to beautiful Banff National Park in Banff, Alberta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Or try our "Voyageur for a Day" IEP Adenture and re-live part of the history of Manitoba.

You'll love Canada and you'll love studying English at the University of Manitoba. See you in the summer!

And the adventure doesn't end in the summer. The Intensive English Program has start dates at the beginning of each month the whole year. Why not experience a Canadian winter as well?

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### What's included in the price?

**Room & Board** - Whether you choose to live with a homestay family or on campus in residence, all of your daily living needs are included.

**Homestay** – Living with a family during your stay will give you the chance to experience Canadian family life first hand. You'll have your own room and shared laundry and bathroom facilities. Your host family provides three meals a day. IEP homestay families are located within 30 minutes or less by bus to the university campus.

**Residence** – If you choose to stay on campus, you'll have a residence room with common bathroom, laundry and kitchen facilities. IEP students eat meals in the residence cafeteria together with other university students. It is just a short walk from your residence room to your classroom.





Health Insurance – Student health insurance is required for all international students in Manitoba. You will be covered from the time you arrive until the time you leave. Coverage includes routine medical services, hospital stays and prescription drugs.

**Experience Manitoba Activities** – All regular cultural and social activities are free of charge and include transportation. IEP Adventures do have additional fees (e.g. Banff trip).

Campus Services – You will get a University of Manitoba student card that will give you access to campus computer labs and libraries. For a small fee you can get a gym membership for your entire IEP program.




- · 6 academic discovery sessions (75 minutes each) with different University of Manitoba faculties
