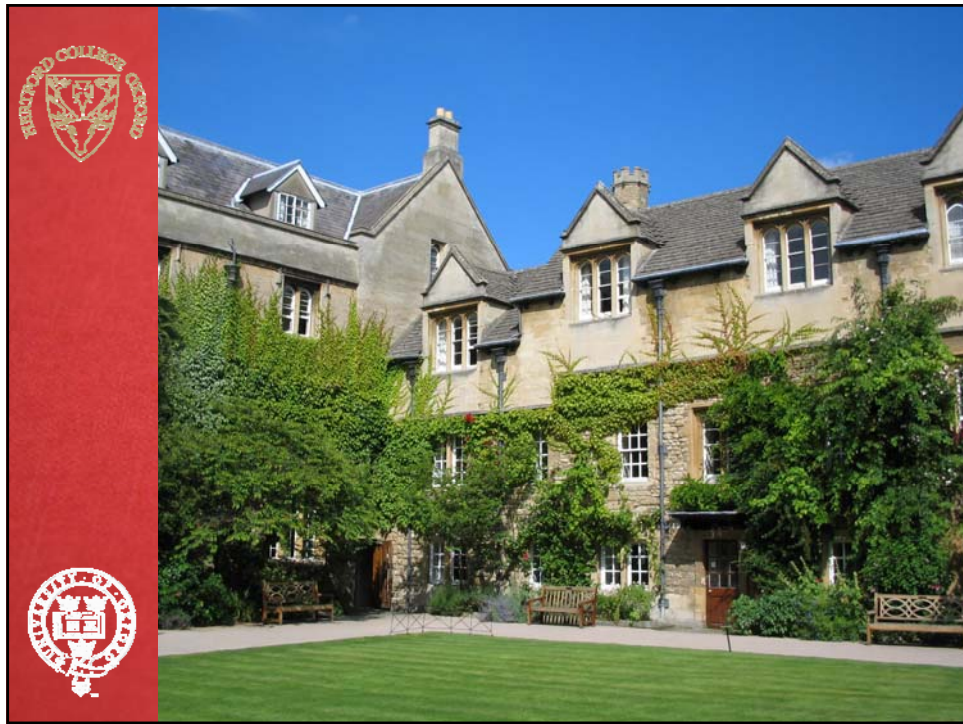


- Hertford is **one of the oldest** of the 38 colleges within the University of Oxford. It was founded in 1282

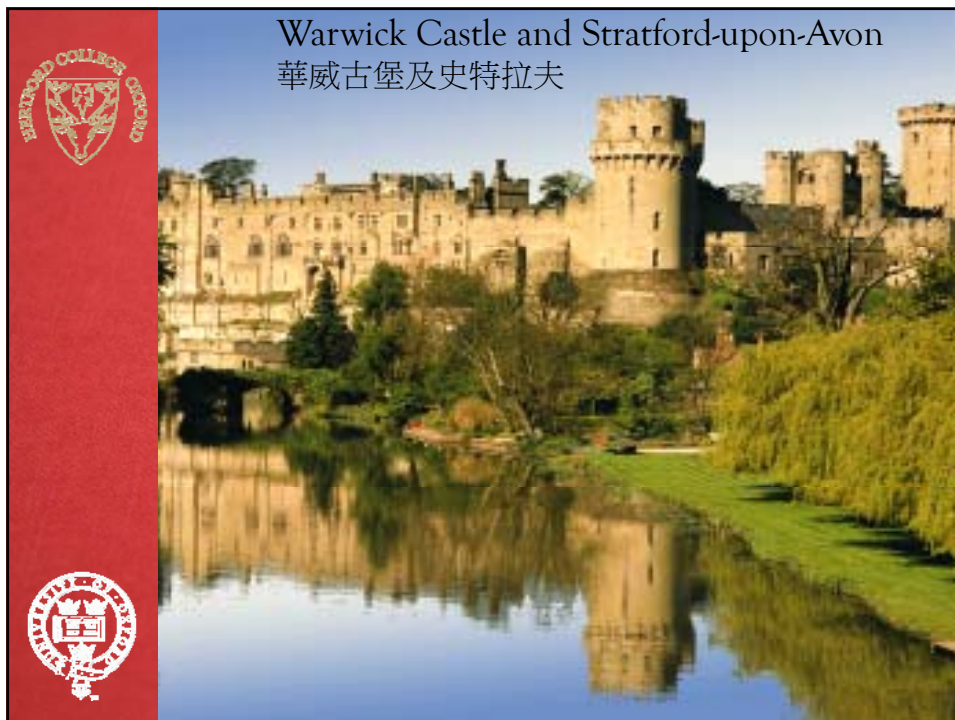


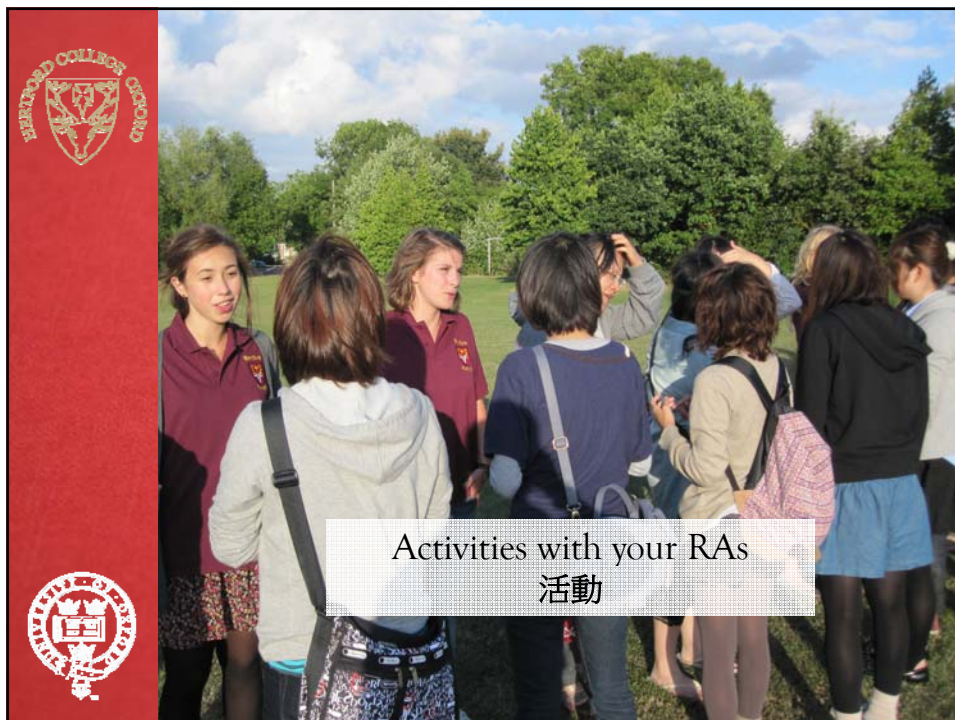
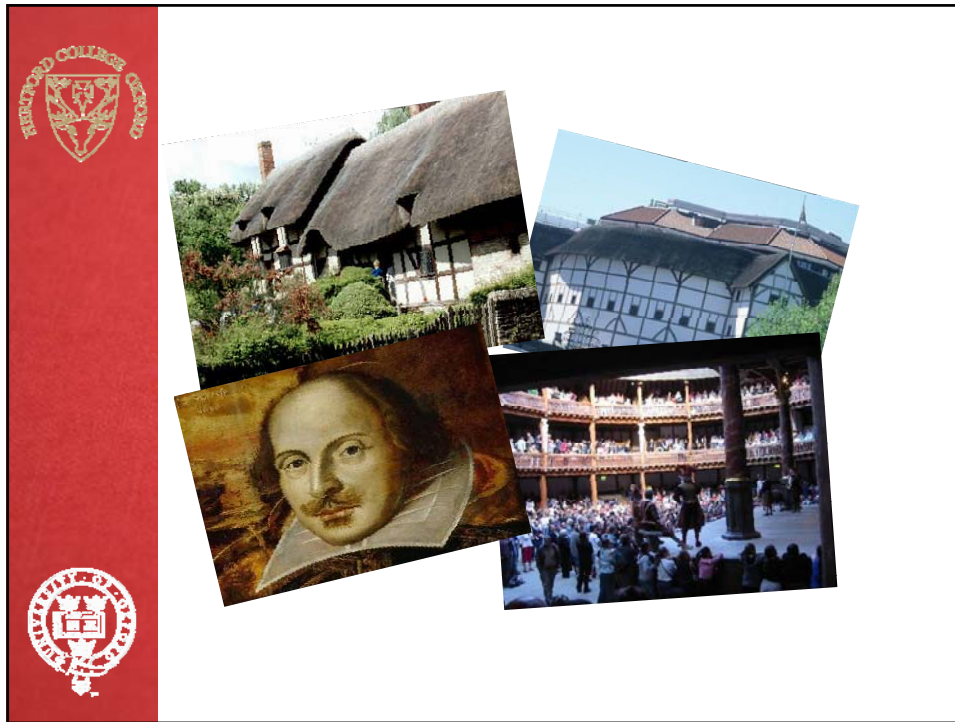














The Residential Advisors are Oxford students who live with you during the programme. You can speak to them and practise your English.
