1. About the Program

The International Summer School I (ISS I) program at the University of Seoul (UOS) was first established in 2000, and it has provided international students with a great opportunity to learn about Korean culture and tradition. Reorganized in 2005, the ISS has been receiving an increased amount of fund from the Seoul Metropolitan Government and offers various incentives to the participants coming from partner universities of the UOS and many prestigious universities over the world.

2. Specialties of the Program

★ **UOS Buddy Program!**

: Starting with welcoming you at the airport, UOS buddies will participate all the activities with you helping you learn about Korea. This provides a valuable chance to make solid friendship.

★ **Mingling with Friends from All over the World!**

: In 2013, you can build a global network by making many friends from Australia, Austria, Canada, China, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Israel, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, The Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Taiwan, UK, USA, and more.

★ **Chance to Explore Busan & Gyeongju or Jeju Island in Korea!**

: A 4-day field trip to Busan & Gyeongju or Jeju Island in Korea will give you a better understanding about Korea.

★ **Various Field Trips and Cultural Activities**

: To learn about Korea's past, present and future, you can experience various kinds of activities while visiting meaningful spots in Korea such as Changdeok Palace (UNESCO World Heritage), Bukchon's Hanok Village and JSA (Joint Security Area). Chances to learn Taekwondo (Korean martial arts), to make Korean traditional masks, and to watch NANTA & JUMP Show will give you unforgettable memories as well.

4. Housing

The UOS offers on-campus dormitory to all participants. Every international student will share a two, three or four-bedroom dormitory with other international students and UOS buddies. The rooms are all single occupancy. Although cooking facility is unavailable in the dorm, you can find a cafeteria in the building for your meals. 5. UOS Buddy

The UOS offers a buddy program to international students. The buddies are UOS Korean students who help international students to adjust themselves to the life in Korea. The UOS buddies offer welcome pick-up service at Incheon International Airport, and participate in most of the programs offered by the ISS with all the international students.

* Undergraduates or Postgraduates from UOS sister universities are eligible for the program.

- (1) Completed application form (in English, downloadable from our website)
- (2) Official transcript (in English)
- (3) A passport-size photo
- (4) Copy of overseas health insurance certificate (in English)
- (5) Copy of passport

* All the application documents should be scanned and be emailed to exchangein@uos.ac.kr via the international office of each applicant's home university with a nomination letter in case of exchange students.

* Non-exchange students can apply to the program by sending all the application documents directly to exchangein@uos.ac.kr

* There is a possibility that on-line application system would launch for the ISS 2013. As soon as the system is prepared, relevant information will be provided.
