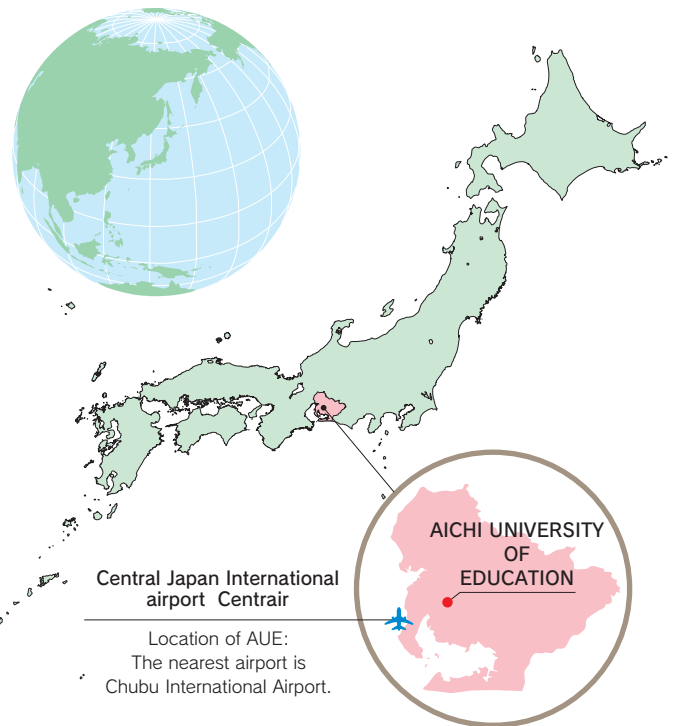

● Profile of Aichi University of Education (AUE) ●

Established in 1873 as the Aichi Prefectural Academy, AUE has been continuously engaged in training capable teachers with a history exceeding 130 years. Having been reorganized in May 1949 as Aichi Gakugei University (National), absorbing three traditional normal schools in Aichi Prefecture under the postwar new education system, it changed its name to Aichi University of Education in 1966, and became incorporated as National University Corporation Aichi University of Education in 2004 to the present.

● Objective

To master the basics of Japanese language required in the international community, having opportunities to experience Japanese society, education and culture.

● Participants

Undergraduates, graduates and academic/clerical staff of the institutions with which AUE concluded the Agreement for International Cooperation and Academic Exchange

● Eligibility

Being a basic course, Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level N4 or higher preferred. Japanese language classes are suitable for students whose Japanese competence is as high as Japanese Language Proficiency Test N3.

● Cost
