

Measures for the Establishment of the National Taiwan Normal University International Academic Cooperation Committee

Approved at the 323rd meeting of the School Administration Council on March 25, 2009

Amended and approved at the 327th meeting of the School Administration Council on March 24, 2010

- Article 1 The National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU) has established the International Academic Cooperation Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee) in order to strengthen international academic cooperation and exchanges between NTNU and its counterparts in other countries.
- Article 2 The committee members shall comprise the NTNU Vice President, Chief Secretary, Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Affairs, Vice President for the Office of Research and Development, Vice President for General Affairs, Deans of various departments, Executive Director of the Mandarin Training Center, Vice President for International Affairs, and the Director of the Division of Research and Industry Liaison. Membership in the committee is an unpaid position.
- Article 3 The NTNU Vice President shall be the chairperson of the committee at its meetings, which relevant personnel may be invited to attend when deemed necessary.
- Article 4 The Committee shall deliberate on or assist in the execution of the following matters:
1. Review and approve agreements pertaining to student and faculty exchange programs with foreign universities that have signed academic cooperation agreements with NTNU.
 2. Review and approve scholarship and subsidy applications for overseas exchange programs.
 3. Other matters related to the promotion of international academic cooperation and cultural exchanges.
- Article 5 The committee shall meet twice every semester. Ad hoc meetings may be convened when necessary.
- Article 6 The administrative affairs of the Committee shall be handled by the Office of International Affairs.
- Article 7 These provisions have been reviewed in meetings of the School Administration Council prior to being implemented. The same review process will be observed when there are amendments to be made to the content.
