Announcing the Summer 2022 J-MCP Programs (August - September 2022)

The J-MCP (Japan-Multilateral COIL/VE Project) is not a conventional COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) course, but online programs jointly implemented by multiple universities located in Japan and overseas.

The J-MCP modules for Summer 2022 will be developed in three fields: **SDGs and Business**, **Diversity and Inclusion**, and **21st Century Skills**. Participants will deepen their knowledge in these fields through collaborative projects with their overseas peers.

1. Program Overview

*Students must apply for this program through their home institutions. Individual applications submitted by students will NOT be processed.

*Students should indicate up to 2 modules (out of 3 modules: SDGs and Business, Diversity and Inclusion, and 21st Century Skills) in order of preference. However, they will only be accepted into a single module.

♦Announcement of Program Selection Results

Program selection results will be sent directly to students' home institutions via email by April 28, 2022 (JST).

Please note that students are not guaranteed a spot in this program, and selection criteria is at the discretion of Kansai University. All selections are final.

3. Program Fees

There are NO application fees or participation fees for this program.

4. Language Proficiency Requirements

The program will be conducted entirely in English. CEFR B2 Level (TOEFL iBT 72+, IELTS 5.5+, Cambridge Examination 160+) English proficiency is recommended for non-native speakers.

*Proof of language certification is NOT required.

5. Digital Badges

Students who successfully complete the program will be eligible for a digital badge to be issued by IIGE (Kansai University) within 3 months of program completion.

Digital badges issued by IIGE are verifiable and meet qualifications for IMS Global Open Badges 2.0. Students' home institutions can review the content of the completed course through the issued badge. Students' home institutions may determine digital badges to be credit-bearing at their discretion.

IIGE/Kansai University does NOT issue credits, transcripts (official or unofficial), letters of credit approval, nor any similar documentation for this program.

6. Program Participation Requirements

♦Access

This program will be conducted 100% online, which requires students to have:

- a stable internet connection able to handle video calls without interruption
- a quality microphone/headset
- a functioning camera-equipped PC

♦Online Platforms

Zoom & ImmerseU

Lectures will be conducted LIVE in English via **Zoom**. Asynchronous (non-live) participation is possible at the discretion of the instructors. If you will be absent from any lecture, you must inform the instructor.

Students will be required to register an account with the <u>ImmerseU CMS</u> (Course Management System) through which various course activities etc. will be conducted. Further information will be provided to students upon enrollment.
