# **APPLICATION PROCESS**

**Step 1:** DBMD applicants first complete an online Global Programs form via the website below. Applicants indicate they are applying to DBMD and select their major of interest.

#### **APPLICATION MATERIALS**

- 1. **DBMD Study Plan:** Select appropriate Temple graduate courses to fulfill remaining undergraduate requirements. If all undergraduate requirements will be completed prior to beginning at Temple, a DBMD Study Plan is not required.
- **2.** Letters of Recommendation: 2-3 letters of recommendation (depending on major) submitted through department-specific application portal.
- 3. Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- **4. TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo Score:** Applicants who have not received a degree in the United States are required to take either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test, or the Duolingo Language Exam.
- 5. Standardized Test Scores: The GRE and GMAT are waived for majors outside of the Fox School of Business. Applicants to Fox may be eligible for a waiver on a case-by-case basis. For Fox applicants not receiving a waiver, GMAT or GRE scores can be forwarded electronically to Temple University's Graduate School (Institution Code: 2906).
- **6. Transcripts:** Official transcripts from colleges/universities attended must be submitted to Temple University via the department-specific application portal.
- 7. Application for Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20): Submitted via separate application:

# **QUALIFICATIONS FOR DBMD PROGRAM**

Entrance requirements vary by major. Graduate program requirements can be found by degree program at <a href="https://bulletin.temple.edu/graduate/">https://bulletin.temple.edu/graduate/</a>. Students have the best chance of being admitted if they meet the following eligibility criteria:

## DBMD Tracks:

- 3+1 or 3+2 Program Apply in third year of undergraduate study for either 1-year or 2-year master's option.
- 4+1 or 4+2 Programs Apply in fourth year of undergraduate study or after graduation for either 1-year or 2-year master's option.
- Minimum TOEFL® iBT 79; IELTS 6.5; Duolingo 110 (majors in disciplines such as Business or Communications require higher scores).
- GPA of 3.5/4.5 (3.0/4.0 or approximately 80%).
- GRE waived for most programs, except Fox School of Business (but waivers considered).
- Completed undergraduate coursework meets most of the academic prerequisites of the graduate program.

Note: Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA while enrolled at Temple.
