

Dual Bachelor's Master's Degree (DBMD) Study Plan Directions

The DBMD Study Plan is only needed for incoming students who still need to complete undergraduate requirements for their home university. If you do not have remaining undergraduate requirements prior to your arrival at Temple, do not submit a DBMD Study Plan.

Directions:

- 1. Meet with your home university Faculty Advisor, Department Head, and International Program Officer to discuss your remaining undergraduate credits.
- 2. With your home university, select appropriate Master's courses to complete your undergraduate requirements during your first year at Temple. If no graduate classes fulfill your remaining undergraduate requirements, please select appropriate undergraduate classes. Remember, undergraduate classes do not count towards your Master's degree at Temple.

 - a. If applicable, please select your Temple senior thesis advisor by October 1 of the Fall Semester (if you intend to take a Spring semester Independent Study).
 - b. If you need an Independent Study, please list it in your DBMD Study Plan.
