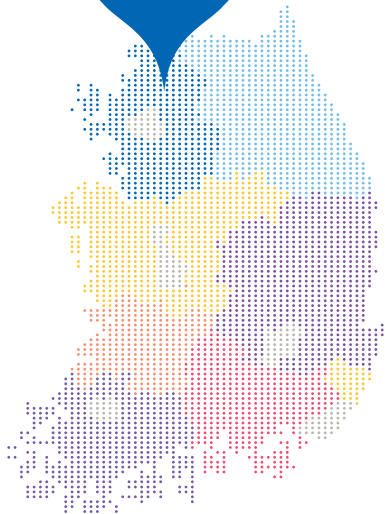

We have 13,700 domestic students and 1,400 international students from 67 countries. The university consists of 12 colleges with leading programs in fields such as artificial intelligence, future automobiles, molecular science and technology, energy systems, a medical center, and a law school.

Our beautiful tree-lined campus offers study and relaxation areas, gyms and sporting facilities, outdoor parks and alfresco cafes along with individual and group study and collaboration rooms, modern high-tech facilities, and even an advanced semiconductor cleanroom.

Students may also take the driverless, fully automated Seoul Metro Line from Ajou University Station to Gangnam in a 34-minute journey.

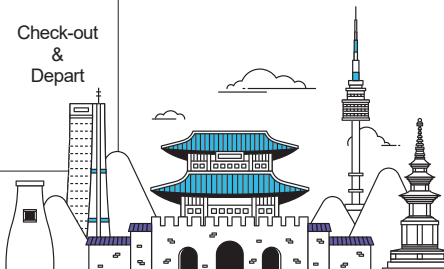
